



How to Fill Out the AR-11 Form

This form must be filled out anytime a non-U.S. citizen moves to a different residence. It must be completed within 10 days of the move. Each family member moving must fill out an AR-11 form online or on paper. This is a legal process that is very important to follow. Failing to do so could affect you and your family's immigration status. Remember to keep copies of the AR-11 forms for your records. You might need this information when you submit adjustment of status applications in the future.

Instructions to fill out the form on paper is on page 1, instructions to fill out the form online is on page 3.

If you are switching your address from one temporary housing placement to another, you will have to refile this form when you move again with your new and updated address.

This form needs to be filled out for every member of the family.

Follow the instruction on Page 2, on how to fill out this form.

Once completed, please fold the form and place it in an envelop. As shown below, please provide:

1. A stamp, which will allow you to send the mail.

Step 1: "Information About You" Section

1. Please write here your family name.

4. Write here your birth date in order of month, day, year.

5. The "Alien Registration Number" is an individual's unique number that begins with "A". You can find this number on your I-94 form or your Employment Authorization Card as the "USCIS", or Immigrant Visa as the "Registration Number".

Step 2: "Information About Your Address" Section

6. Under "Present Physical Address/New Address" please include all information for your new home address.

6.a. Write here your new street address (ex. 245 Henry Street).

6.b. Write here your new home number.

* If you live in an apartment check "Apt."
 * If you live in a suite check "Ste."
 * If you live on a whole floor check "Flr."

In the "Number" box, include the number of the apartment/suite/floor (ex. apt. 2A).

6.c. Write here the new city/town you now live in (ex. Seattle, Turlock, Phoenix).

6.d. Choose here the new state you now live in from the options. The options are abbreviated into two letters (ex. Washington is "WA", California is "CA", Arizona "AZ").

6.e. Write here your new "Zip Code", this is a 5-digit number (ex. 10015, 27109, 46312).

7. Under "Previous Physical Address/Old Address" please include all information for your previous place of residence (can be temporary or permanent housing). This is the address of where you moved from to your current address. Please input your IRC office's address if you don't have a previous address in the US.

8. "Mailing Address" will be filled out with the same information from "Present Physical Address" if you are able to receive mail at your new address. If you are living in temporary housing, you can enter the IRC office address or a US relative's permanent address as your mailing address.

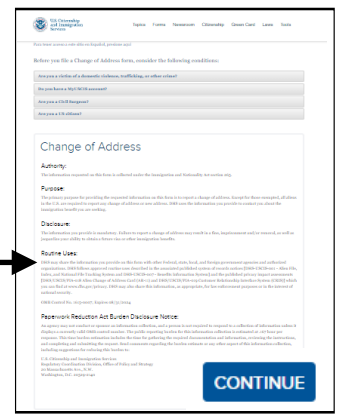
